CONCLUSION

We have come to see that teenage mothers need to be counselled and supported as they also deserve equal opportunity. If we want to achieve **universal health coverage** we have to put in consideration teenage girls and teenage mothers by focusing to those from rural area as are those who face many life-threatening problems due to lack of adequate knowledge on the new situation they are entering in. furthermore, their babies are likely to suffer from malnutrition and if we want to abolish malnutrition we have to support them teenage mothers. As prevention to these bad consequences we have to build many teenage girls club where they can get adequate knowledge so that they avoid stepping into this bad path of getting pregnant before time and we have to encourage teenage girls to go into schools as education for girls is very important. There are many teenage girls and teenage mothers who have been harassed or deprived their rights so we have to make advocacy so that they get approached and saved.
